Hi Patrick,

How would you like me to proceed filing this leveraged impact for 21-037? Below you will find a brief summary of the leveraged impact. I will also follow up with Hyginus to ask how much the renovation cost.

On the day of the official launch of the Project Educate A Kid, we extended an invitation to the Local Government Chairman and the Education Secretary of Kaduna North Local Government Education Authority to witness the event. During the launch, we informed them how the local leader, community members collaborated with World Connect to set up the hub and told them how much was needed, especially infrastructural developments, to further enhance academic achievements in the school. The Education Secretary and Local Government Chairman Promised to escalate our request to higher authorities and in fact they did. We followed up with courtesy visits and calls and within three months of launching the project, approval was given by the state government to renovate the entire block of classrooms in the school. The school renovation resulted in increased students' enrollment which led to an increase in the number of pupils who benefitted from the digital literacy training ongoing in the school.

Hello Vanessa,

I've got more information regarding the Renovations.

In total, three buildings were renovated, they generally are of the same type but different sizes. The type of building is a Standard Block of Classroom. More Specifically, the first building is an "L-Shaped Standard Block of Classroom" with 6 classrooms (each measuring 8m x 6m approximately 500 sq. ft.), the second building is an "I-Shaped Standard Block of Classroom" with 2 classrooms (each measuring 8m x 6m approximately 500 sq. ft.) and third building is an "L-Shaped Standard Block of Classroom" with 8 classrooms (each measuring 8m x 6m approximately 500 sq. ft.). All three buildings were renovated, meaning there was no new construction but the old structures existent in the school were renovated, the roofing sheets changed and the whole blocks of classrooms repainted.

According to the local contractor I spoke with, it cost an estimated sum of Two Million, Four Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, Eight Hundred and Thirty Naira only (N 2,454, 830) to renovate the "L-Shaped Standard Block of Classroom" and an estimated One Million, Four Hundred and Twenty Naira only (N1,000,420) to renovate the "I-Shaped Standard Block of Classroom"

I have also attached pictures of the renovated blocks of classrooms to provide you with more clarity.
