

Fundraising tips and suggestions

Bake Sale

- Bake home-made treats or talk to a local bakery to sell the club food at a discounted price
- ► Hold a themed bake sale- Valentines Day, St. Patrick's Day, Halloween etc.
- Sell food at school sporting events

Movie Night

- ➤ Host a movie night at your school or a communal space. Show a movie or documentary related to your project; either about your specific country or particular issue your project is focused on
- Charge entry fee (Suggestion: \$5-\$10)
- Sell candy, food and drinks

Out of Uniform Day

- ➤ Does your school require a uniform? Host an out of uniform day! Have people pay to wear dress down clothes on a particular day (Suggestion: \$1-\$5)
- > To everyone who participates, make sure to educate them about what they are supporting

Spare Change

- ➤ Decorate a bucket and leave it in your club's classroom along with a flyer describing your project
- ➤ Have students dump their spare change in the bucket. You may think it makes little cents, but it adds up!
- Set a fundraising goal that works best for you and your school; every amount counts!
- Create engaging flyers, posters and info graphics to explain your project and why you are taking a stand
