SUBJECT: RECOMMENDATION LETTER FOR CHAMAZA YOUTH ORGANIZATION

The Malawi Human Rights Youth Network (MHRYN) was founded in May, 2001 as a Non-Governmental Organization to support youths and children as one of the vulnerable groups through programs that focus on Democratic Governance and Human Rights, Health, and Socio-economic and political Empowerment and Environmental Management. The programs are delivered through its various affiliate organizations most of which operate at the local level while MHRYN plays a coordinating role at national level. The network has an active membership in over forty-Six (46) districts throughout the three regions (Central, Northern and Southern) of the country. Presently, there are over sixty-five (73) youth organizations affiliated to MHRYN representing a direct reached population of over 300,000 youths. This makes MHRYN the youth organization with the widest reach in Malawi

Malawi Human Rights Youth Network has been working with Chamaza Youth Organization for the past 7 years on programmes of youth empowerment, Child Rights, Environment, Governance, Advocacy and engagement in different with duty bearers on accountabilitys in different areas one of the key highlights of the partnership was when we worked with them to engage duty bearers on Youth Empowerment and Participation On Local Governance project funded by United National Democracy Fund, Youth Participation and Accountability on Local Government Structures project funded by USAID AND DFID through National Democratic Institute and on the presidential candidate for 2014 elections to make a commitment to the youth and children of Malawi which culminated into signing by all the candidate on the declaration of the 10 commitments to youths and children of Malawi funded by UNICEF.

Malawi Human Rights Youth Network recommends Chamaza Youth Organization has a strong, vibrant, confidential, integrity, transparent and accountability not forgetting hard working organization which has first-hand experience working with the communities both rural and urban sectors and they have a professional and organized team that are able to handle funds dispersed to them for different projects.
