What year was your community organization founded and what is its origin story?

The association AJNDF has been founded in November 2015. The idea of that group results in the need that occurred by the lack of connection between the young of Les Cayes, specifically Derriere Fort. Before 2015 we've never had some activities between the young people of that community, even for the most important days. So it was more than necessary that we come up with a solution to overcome this situation. So on November 2015, we've call all the young people of Derriere Fort to take part in cleaning and decorating the street. And years later, we've kept that use, and added some extra activity. This how we've created the association AJNDF.

What are your organization's current programs/activities?

As AJNDF is an association of young people, so our main activities turn around how young people can progress in their life, how we could help them taking in hand their destiny, how we could help them find the right path for their future. To achieve that goal we organize, a series of discussion about subjects that are important for their future like leadership point that can improve their way of thinking and their dreams, professional orientation to help them make a right choice in their career, clean up streets and others.

The project will start in July 2018 and is estimated to last 2 months.

AN'N KODE is a coding bootcamp will be organized in the city of Les Cayes, which aims to train 40 young people of that city in programming computer, creating web application. This project core value is to show young man and woman how they can build awesome resources by working together and increase their capacity to think and solve challenges, by helping each other in their difficulty. Moreover, they would be able to integrate the technology by conceiving their own application.

This project will affect young people from the community of Les Cayes, often referred to as Aux Cayes (Haitian Creole: Okay), is a commune and seaport in the Les Cayes Arrondissement, in the South department of Haiti, with a population of 71,236. Due to its isolation from the political turmoil of the capital, Port-au-Prince, it is one of Haiti's major ports, with export trade concentrating on mostly coffee and sugarcane. As the world's largest supplier of vetiver, it exports 250 tons annually of this ingredient of perfume and fragrance manufacturing. Minor exports include bananas and timber. We are targeting a group in the age range of 15 to 25 years. The project will be hosted by a school in the locality of Les Cayes with a computer lab that can accommodate a group of 50. Around the school we have a clerkship several other schools, a dental clinic, a non-governmental organization OMI (Oblates of Mary Immaculate Conception).

Please describe daily life for the individuals who will participate in your proposed project.

Jimmy Cardona is a young from Les Cayes. He was born and grew up there. He lost his mother since his childhood and left school due to a lack of money to pay his school fees. In his days, Jimmy use to stay at his house doing nothing. Sometimes he starts his day trying to get some cash, but sometime all are in vain. Through ANN KODE the possibility will be offered to Jimmy to have a way to earn his life by working as a programmer, creating web application.

How was the project determined as a priority by the community? Please specify how women were involved in this process.

The city of Les Cayes has a brilliant youth, which is able to work on anything; they are motivated and strong enough to work on any field. This can be seen in the result of the official exam. There are always more than 4 young people coming from Les Cayes in the top ten. However, one of the major

issues we have been pointing out, iKod a group of young people studying computer scientist, is that that youth does not involve them in the technology. They rather use it, as if they were really not interested on the how things are been built, what's happening under the wood. So following this conversation we've found out the best way to help them overcoming that situation is to show them how they can create their own technological product, how they can be creative, how they can use their imagination. And in the field of technology when you are talking about creativity you mean programming. This lack of imagination and technology inclusion implies a low level of technological activity in the city of Les Cayes.

AJNDF will be the main group responsible to manage the activity related to logistic and food. They will provide the volunteer for that.

He needs to keep in touch with all the people in Les Cayes who are helping us in the activity. However, he needs to have an eye on almost everything related to the project. His last and most important usage in the design and implementation of the project is to ensure that our specific goals are accomplished in the required environment.

This project aims an educational scope. That is why, easily we have a bunch of people from Les Cayes who are willing to bring their own contribution to this project. First, we have the College Saint Jean who is eager to support us by letting us use his laboratory and his own electricity generator. Second, we have a group of university student in Les Cayes who wants to share with these young man and woman their knowledge in the field of programming. And there are young people in the AJNDF group who want to volunteer in the activity to manage things such as required food for each of the sessions we will have in the bootcamp.

What are your sustainability strategies for this project? For example, five years from now, what will remain, who will be responsible for what remains, and what ongoing costs do you foresee?

One of the biggest objectives of the project AN'N KODE is to create a community of young computer programmer in the city of Les Cayes. So as a community the most important is to be linked together, to help each other and give the opportunity for others to integrate the group and share the same value with us. This is the main way our project will be sustained. By the community that will be resulted from the bootcamp. The individual action of each participant will have a considerable impact on how the other young people who do not have any knowledge in programming will be influenced and join our community for the best. However, it will be possible for us to go in the other city to spread the habit of grouping young man and woman to create community of programmer.

How does the community, particularly women, define success for this project? Please list their three most important success indicators. Describe how each of these indicators will be measured and by whom.

- For our project, first indicator that can measure success is the number of people in Les Cayes that are supporting us, willing to participate actively with us. This will mean they needed this activity a long time ago and though it is necessary for them to keep it on the go. - Second indicator is how many of our beneficiaries that are still working on project given to them, or created their own project to keep learning programming even after the bootcamp has finished - The last one is very important because it measures the necessity of creating web resources for businesses in the city. And it measures the average of money beneficiaries of the bootcamp are winning by working on what they've learned.

What will be the impact of your project on the community, and specifically on women? What will it change for the community, and specifically for women?

The first impact will be on the life of these young, the will have the opportunity to create new incomes. For the city of les Cayes, people and businesses will have programmer available to overcome their needs in that field. In addition, they will have opportunity to expand their activity through web site that these young people will create for them. This project will show to people of Les Cayes and it surrounded how women can easily adapt themselves to technology. They will have the possibility to show what they can do else other than the stereotype assigned to them more often. Personally, women will develop themselves, and open their mind to the outer world.
