Memorandum Of Understanding

The aim of Thare Machi Education is

To provide knowledge and hope for women and children in the developing world. Using cheap reliable DVD technology and connecting with community groups at grass roots level we are working to produce 50 audiovisual lessons in basic life skills in the languages of the world's most vulnerable and disadvantaged.

This MOU sets out the basis for ongoing collaboration between,

- Thare Machi Education (TME)
- Listen First International Uganda (LiFI-U)

Aims

To establish a programme to provide TME health education DVDs to vulnerable people in Uganda

To evaluate the effectiveness of the TME learning methodology by examining both knowledge AND behaviour changes in the people who watch the DVDs

To produce TME lessons in additional local languages if needed

TME responsibilities:

- DVD lessons
 - o TME will provide DVDs in Ateso, Runyankole, Acholi and other languages as required, subject to availability, and at a cost to be agreed
 - Where appropriate TME will create new languages versions of DVD lessons subject to availability of funding and collaboration on resourcing translations/recordings
- **Funding**
 - There is no direct funding available from TME, but TME will work with LiFI-U as required on any funding applications to resource this project

LiFI-U responsibilities

- Planning
 - Working with TME and other local partners to make a realistic plan for distributing and showing DVDs

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- Distribution/screening of DVDs
 - Work with TME to ensure that DVDs are distributed as required
 - Share knowledge and experience in order that partners can use the DVDs effectively and can record details of all viewings.
 - Supply machine to view lessons e.g DVD player (standard or portable), laptop ,desktop or projector.
- Reporting
 - Communicate regularly with TME to provide reports on progress and identify problems
 - Report on use of lessons and progress of the distribution every three months.
- Translations
 - Assist with and co-ordinate translation of English lesson scripts into local language if required
- Recordings
 - Assist with and co-ordinate recording of new local language scripts as needed if required

Timeframe

It is anticipated that this will be a rolling project and from the outset that both parties view this as a long term project, however this MOU will cover 06 June 2019 to 31 December 2019 in the first instance.
