They were always ready to share their knowledge and help us to work with the youth from the communities. They were always serious and welcoming with us. And of course they have a business also, but the most important thing is that they believe in what they do, because they not only make briquettes but they make an impact here in Dzaleka and Malawi, and together during these three days of training we will make this impact bigger.

The problem of the deforestation in Malawi is really serious, and this affects all of us. In 40 years 50% of the forests have vanished, and we need to do something. But of course, we need charcoal to cook every day. So then what? Well, Dieudonne and all his team are having different possibilities and alternative solutions.
