Our humanitarian facilitating initiative support is purposely intended to engage and empower people with physical disabilities through our farming and agriculture social enterprise business project's activities alongside sustainable food/financial earning returns.



BEFI PROJECT BUDGET AND FUNDING NEED

We started small with our own savings and support from relatives and friends by first investing in land purchase at Soga, Kibaha District, Coast Region, Tanzania. Established a small-scale self-help farm and started constructions of the now progressing farm house/poultry house building structures, planted land/farm surrounding teak trees, planted now yielding various food/commercial fruit trees, growing of same food/commercial miscellaneous crops, to raise commercial chickens (now keeping few for trials) for the local market and beyond. The grant funds resource being sought will facilitate us finish the project's farm house/poultry house building structures on-going construction progressing work which will include making these building structure entries easily accessible by us all disabled and non-disabled, installation of rain water harvesting facilities and digging of water boreholes for simple drip irrigations (focusing on continuous food/commercial miscellaneous crop harvestings, crop rotations and controlling of crop wastes), area fencing, project accessing to electrical/solar powers and acquiring of other essential project utilities thus make the project fully operational, triggering further involvement of more people with physical disabilities together with additional of food/commercial pawpaw, mushrooms, bee hives and fish keeping products production facilities and land expansions, one after another.
